Modern slavery and human trafficking is any form of forced labour, child labour, debt slavery, human trafficking, or other forms of exploitation of individuals. At GRANORTE, we are committed to combatting modern slavery and human trafficking in all its forms. We recognize that these crimes pose a grave violation of human rights and are determined to ensure that our business operations and supply chains are free from any involvement in such practices. This Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy outlines our commitment to prevent, detect, and address any potential risks of modern slavery and human trafficking. This policy applies to all aspects of our business, including our employees, customers, suppliers, and other business partners.

Compliance with Laws and Regulations:

We will comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and international standards relating to modern slavery and human trafficking. Reporting and Whistleblower Protection:

We encourage all employees and stakeholders to report any concerns or suspicions of modern slavery or human trafficking through our designated reporting channels. Whistleblowers will be protected from retaliation, and their reports will be handled confidentially and with appropriate investigation and action.
